




#### **Prior to installation:**


- Make sure you have access to the code base of your website


# Log in to your AllAccessible account




### Click the "Add New Site" Button




Add the site you would like to add the AllAccessible application to. Be sure to enter the URL including the subdomain (www) for your preferred site.




Your site should be added to your dashboard.



### Click the "How to Add to Your Site" button.




## Access your website files and open the header file.



Within the Header PHP file, add a space before the head tag closes.


Navigate back to the AllAccessible dashboard and click the "Copy" button within the "Manually Install Code" section. This will copy the embed code for you.




Paste the embed code within the space you previously created before your closed head tag within your PHP Header file.

Save your Header file and upload it back to the server.



Navitage back to your website and reload. The AllAccessible app should appear on your site. If the app does not appear immediately, you may need to reload multiple times, or reset your cache.
