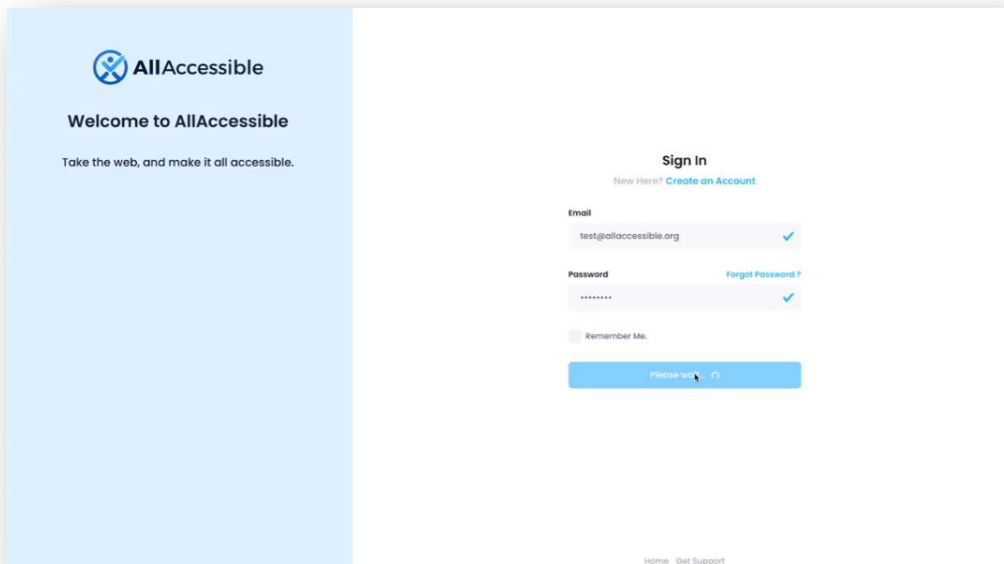

- Make sure you have access to your AllAccessible Dashboard by signing up for an AllAccessible trial or subscription

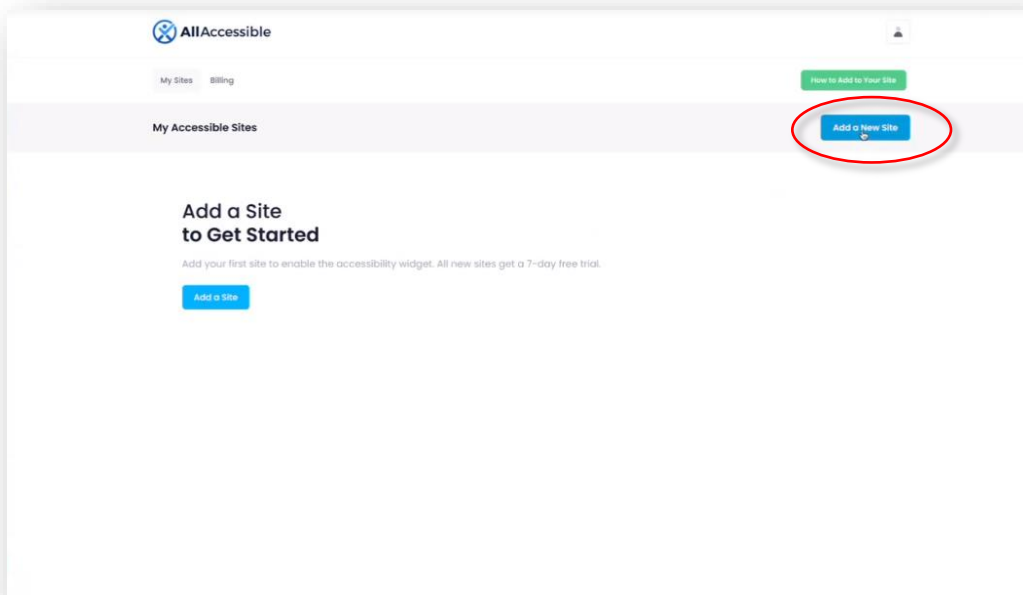

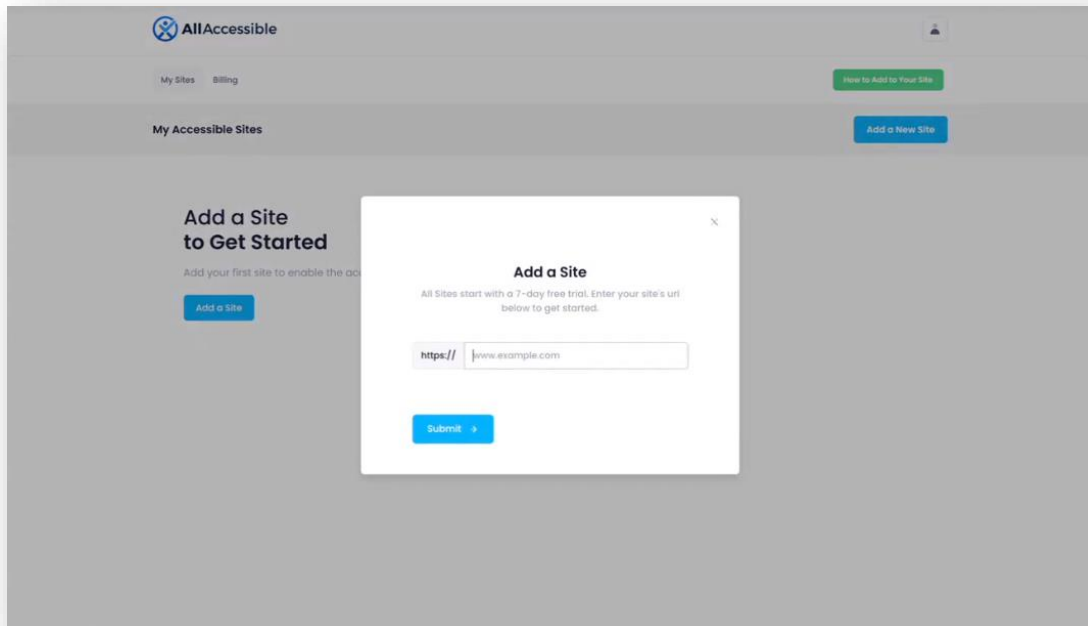



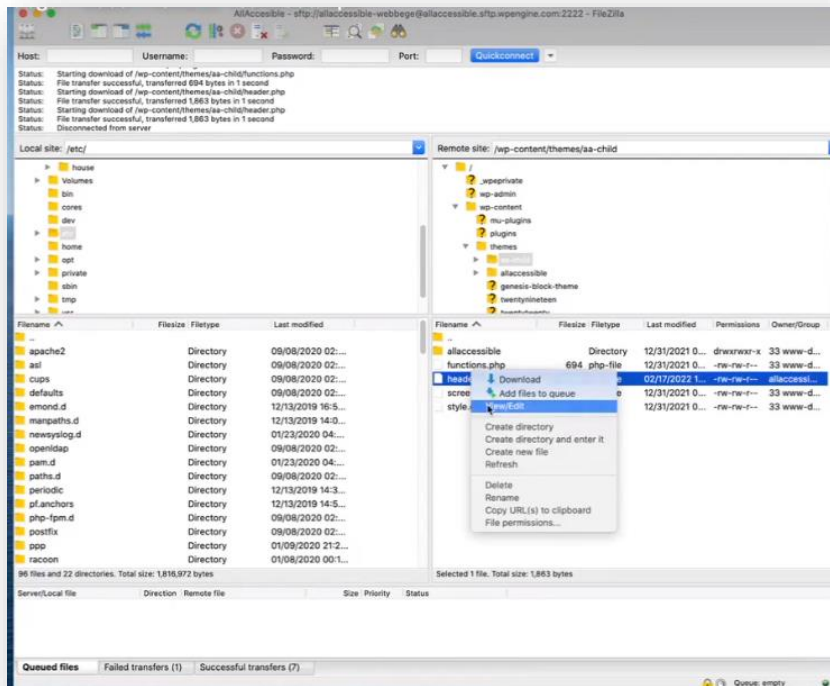

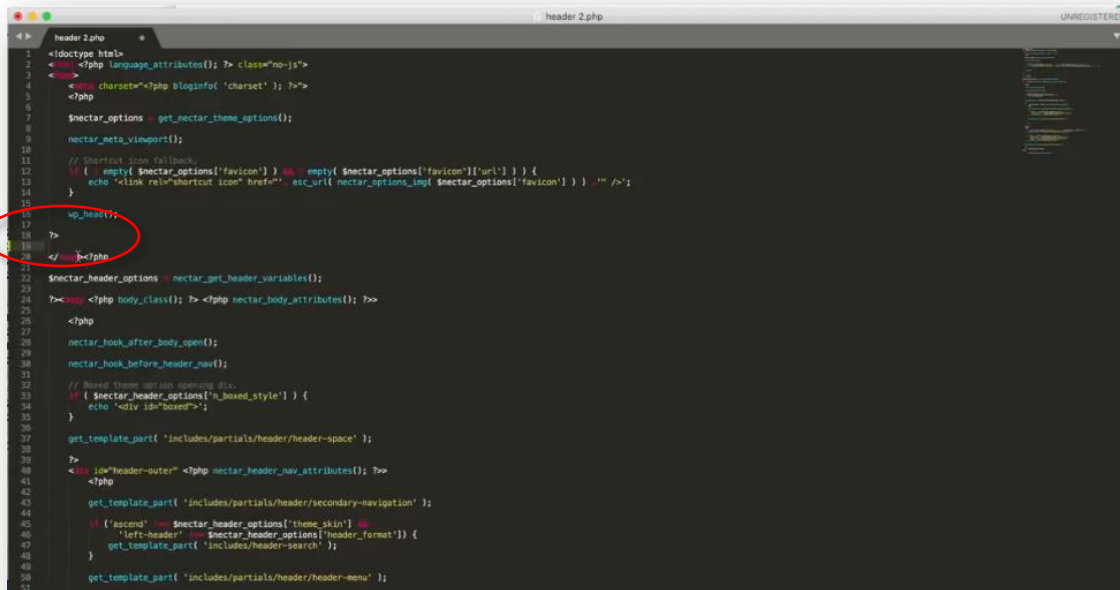
Click the “How to Add to Your Site” button.



Access your website files and open the header file.

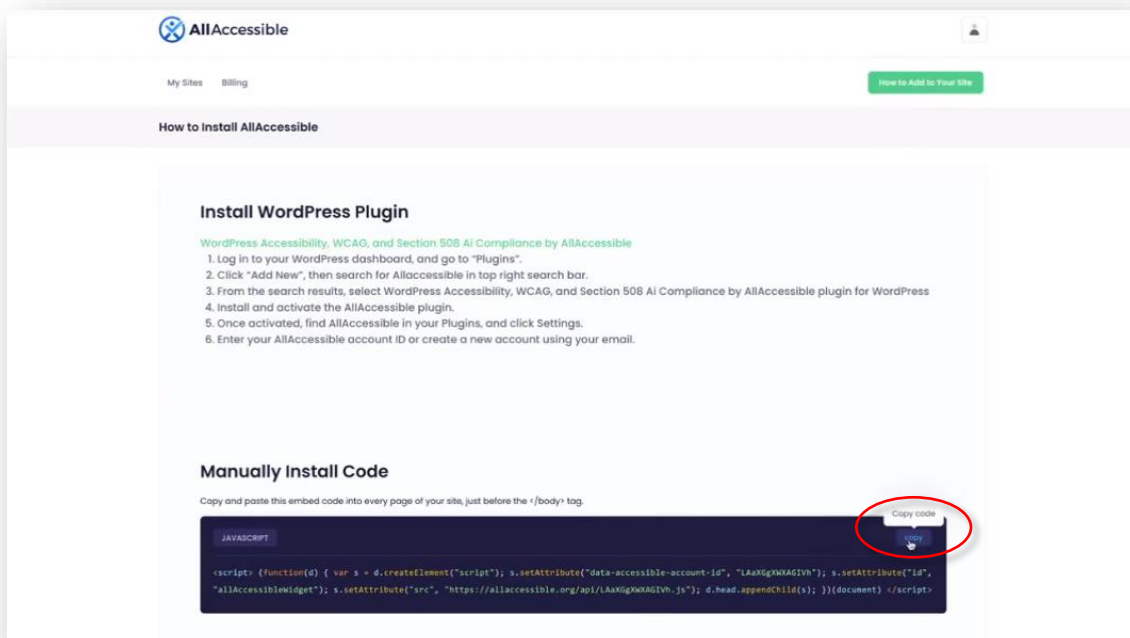


Within the Header PHP file, add a space before the head tag closes.

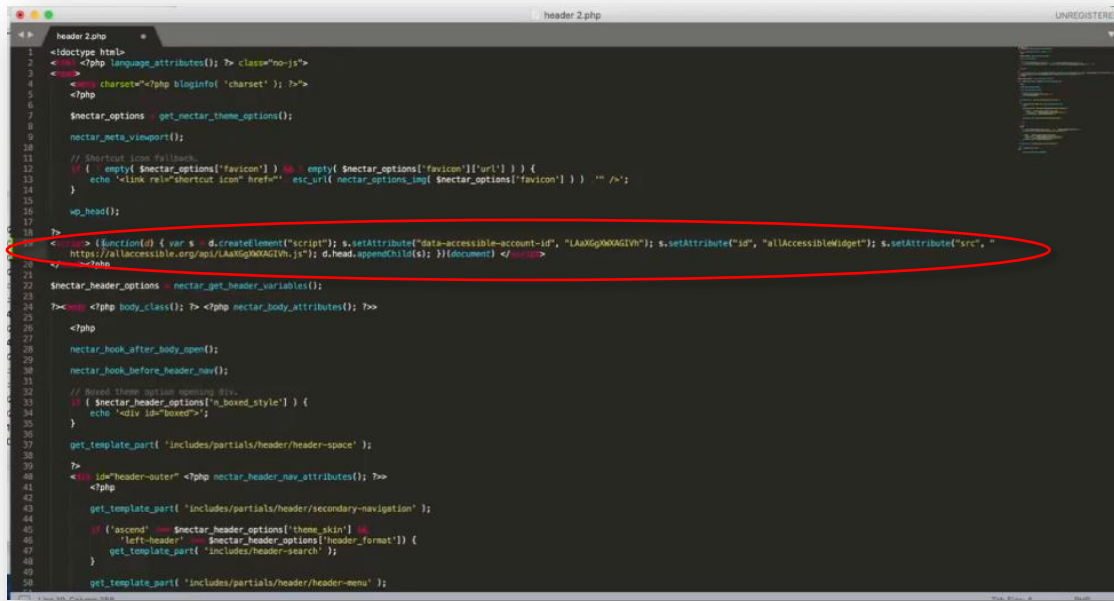

Navigate back to the AllAccessible dashboard and click the “Copy” button within the “Manually Install Code” section. This will copy the embed code for you.

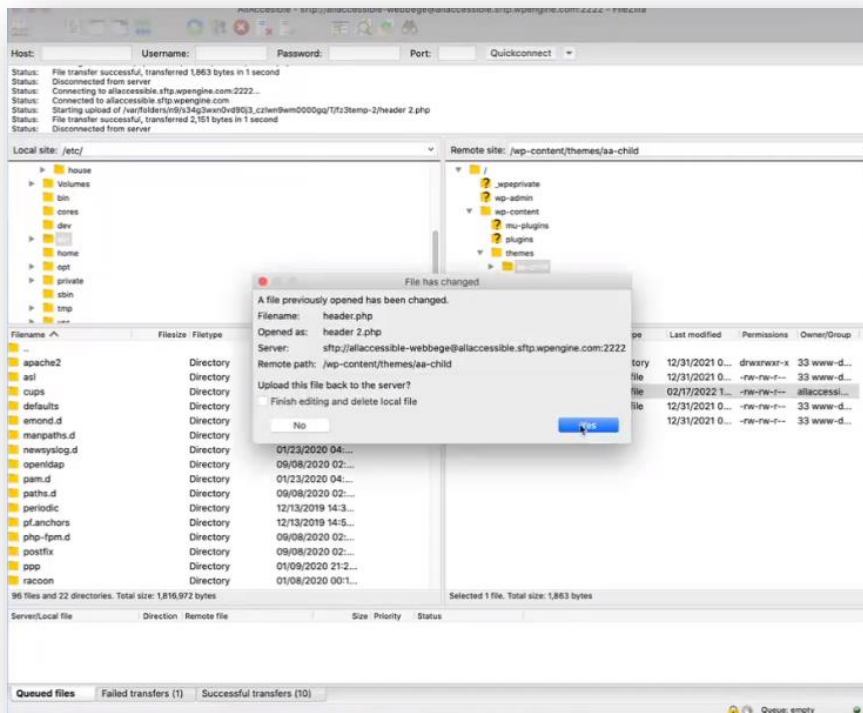


Paste the embed code within the space you previously created before your closed head tag within your PHP Header file.

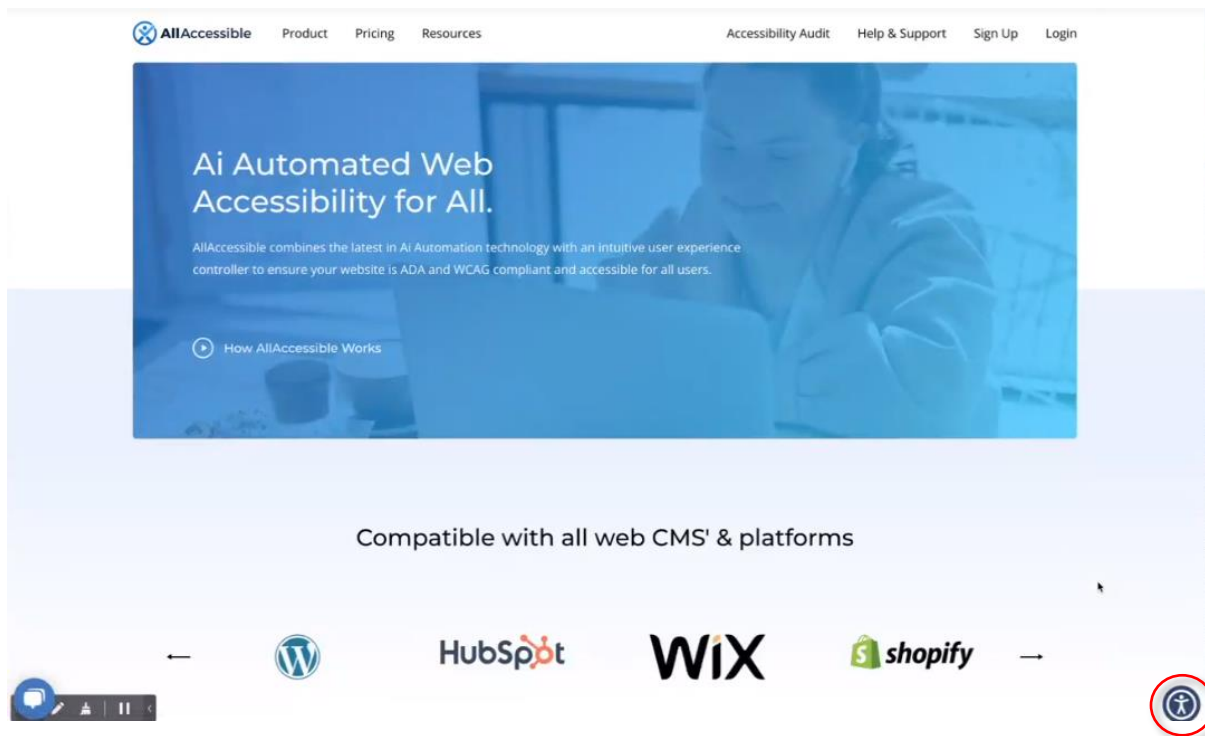

Save your Header file and upload it back to the server.
